

Getting to Aikido Kobayashi Dojo

You have 2 options: **BUS** or **TRAIN**.

The best way is to take a bus. The bus goes from Narita Airport to Tokorozawa directly, so you don't have to walk up and down at crowded stations in Tokyo with your heavy luggage.

The second best way is to take trains. You should take trains when you don't have a bus at an appropriate time when you arrive to Narita airport.

******* BY BUS *******

Take a bus from Narita Airport to Tokorozawa Station.

At Narita Airport bus ticket counter, buy a one-way bus ticket to Tokorozawa Station. Check from which bus stop the bus leaves at the counter. Note that before arriving to Tokorozawa station, the bus makes a brief stop at Higashi-Tokorozawa station. **DO NOT GET OFF** the bus at HIGASHI-TOKOROZAWA STATION.

The final destination of the bus is **Tokorozawa Station**, and that is where you get off the bus. The one-way bus ticket costs **3,000 yen**.

Then, from Tokorozawa station...

To Kodaira Dojo

—If you arrive on **Wednesday, Friday** or **Saturday**, please come to **Kodaira Dojo**.

1. From **Tokorozawa Station**, take the **Seibu Shinjuku Line** for **Seibu Shinjuku Station** to **Kodaira Station** (170 yen).
2. Take a taxi from **Kodaira Station South Exit** to Aikido Kobayashi Dojo. “Aikido Kobayashi Dojo onegai-shimasu!” Say this magical phrase to the taxi driver, and you will find yourself in front of Kodaira dojo in 5 minutes (710 yen for the taxi).

To Tokorozawa Dojo

—If you arrive on **Tuesday, Thursday** or **Sunday**, please come to **Tokorozawa Dojo**.

1. From **Tokorozawa Station**, take the **Seibu-Shinjuku Line** bound for **Honkawagoe** or **Shin-Tokorozawa** to **Koku-Koen Station** (140 yen). **DO NOT TAKE A LIMITED EXPRESS TRAIN!** Any other train can take you to **Koku-Koen Station**.
2. Walk from **Koku-Koen Station West Exit** to Tokorozawa Dojo. (Approx 5 minutes walk.)

***** **BY TRAIN** *****

Take a Skyliner train at Keisei Narita Airport Terminal.

1. Take **Skyliner** from Narita Airport terminal to **Nippori** station (1,920 yen).
2. At Nippori station, change train to **JR Yamanote line**, and go to **Takadanobaba** station (160 yen).

To Kodaira Dojo

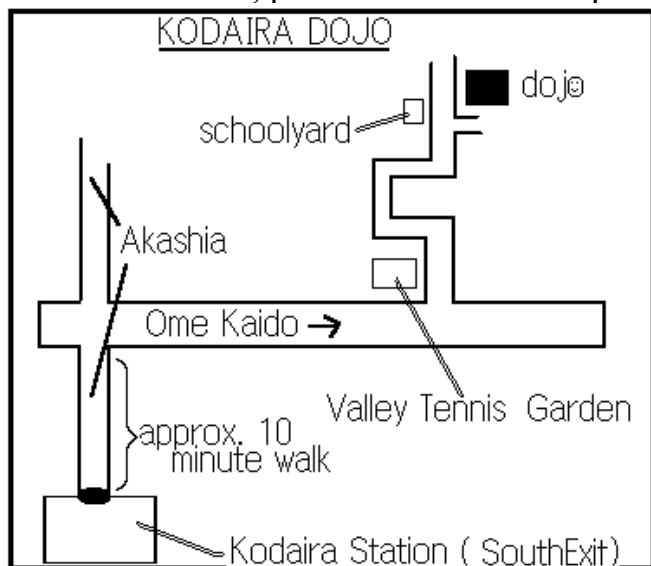
—If you arrive on **Wednesday, Friday** or **Saturday**, please come to **Kodaira Dojo**

3. At Takadanobaba station, change train to Seibu Shinjuku line, and take an express or a semi-express train bound for **Hon-kawagoe** or **Hanno**. **DO NOT TAKE A LIMITED EXPRESS TRAIN**. Get off the train at **Kodaira** station (290 yen).
4. At Kodaira station south exit, take a taxi. Yell to the cab driver, “**Aikido Kobayashi Dojo, onegai-shimasu!**”. Pay the taxi fare (710 yen) when you get off the taxi.

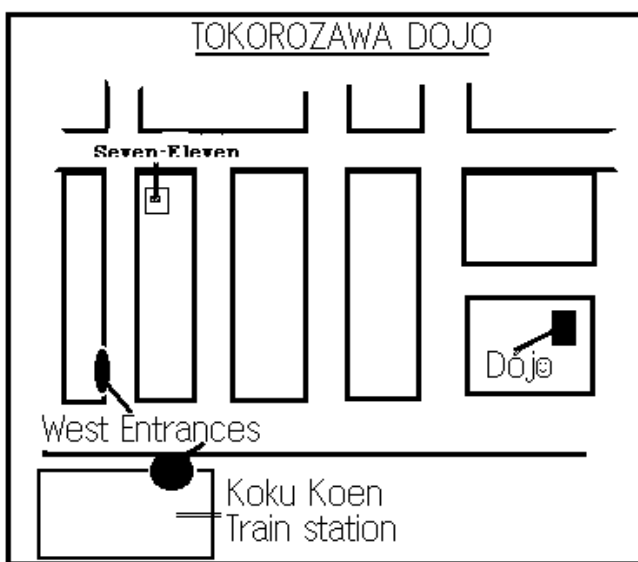
To Tokorozawa Dojo

—If you arrive on **Tuesday, Thursday** or **Sunday**, please come to **Tokorozawa Dojo**.

3. At Takadanobaba station, change train to Seibu Shinjuku line, and take an express or a semi-express train bound for **Hon-kawagoe**. **DO NOT TAKE A LIMITED EXPRESS TRAIN**. Get off the train at **Kokukoen** station (360 yen).
4. From Kokukoen station west exit, walk to Tokorozawa dojo. It's a 5 minutes walk. For directions, please refer to the map shown below.
